Y6 Parents' meeting

As you already know, you are invited in on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at 5.30pm to 6.15pm to meet with senior leaders and year leaders who will explain what will happen during transition week and answer any questions you have. The event will take place in the New Building and refreshments will be available on arrival. On the evening, we will let you know who your child's form tutor is and how you will be able to contact them in September. We also hope to be able to give you timetables for transition week so you can see when they need PE kit.

We suggest if possible not bringing your son/daughter as we plan to meet with you in classrooms and we will run out of room if everyone turns up; and we are giving you the opportunity to ask any questions. However, we do understand that childcare can be a challenge for some parents and we would rather have you present than you miss out, so if necessary do bring them along.

Transition Week

We are excited to welcome your child to Dinnington on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019 for our transition week.

Students should arrive by 8.30 am and the day will begin with an assembly in the hall. They should wear the Dinnington High School uniform including the blazer. We will, of course, allow students to remove their blazer during the day if it is too hot. Ties will be issued in the morning; you can purchase more from reception if you wish. Students should ensure they bring their PE kit with them on the relevant day; this can be their new DHS kit or what they currently wear for PE in primary school.

If you have been unable to buy all the uniform prior to the summer please let us know on [transition@dinningtonhigh.co.uk](mailto:transition@dinningtonhigh.co.uk) and we will ensure your child's form tutor and year leaders are notified. We do have some loan stock available if necessary.

We will provide children who are eligible for free school meals with a lunch during transition week. We are liaising with primary schools about this. All other children should bring a packed lunch with them.

School will close at 12 noon on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July and re-open to students on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September, starting at 8.35 am.
